The name of the home was inspired by a woman named Ardis Anne Smith. Her family called her Ardy. Ardy was on this earth a short time before she passed away in an automobile accident. In the time that Ardy was here, she inspired her entire family to walk with God. Ardy had two young boys at the time of her death, David and Danny that she left behind. Ardy's two sons currently are grown men who help in the community by spreading the Gospel, mental health and addiction recovery assistance, and remaining true to the light that Ardy represented in God. Ardy was described by her sons as being warm, humble, faithful, loving and devoted to God and her family. This is the hope that we have for each man that comes through the Ardy House. Ardy's life taught us that it is not about the quantity of time on this earth that makes a difference, but rather the quality of life devoted to service, love and God. Our mission is to help men in recovery to see their worth, dignity, value and purpose within their community, friends, and family through the power of Christ.

ELIGIBILITY

- 18+ years of age
- Struggling with addictions
- Desire to change your life
- Self motivated to work a program
- Willing to make a 9-12 month program commitment
- Completed minimum of any required time in jail/prison
- Willing to submit to a national background check
- Can pass a drug screen or willing to admit yourself into a detox program prior to starting at the ARDY House
- Have an attitude of willingness, humility and honesty

VISION / MISSION

Vision: To provide recovery services for men struggling with drug and alcohol addiction.

Mission: To assist men in recovery to see their worth, dignity, value and purpose within their community, friends, and family through the power of Christ.

PROGRAM PHASES

⇒ **First 2-4 Weeks at the ARDY House**

A period that begins with setting goals and to begin the process of addressing physical, mental and emotional needs through local professional care providers.

⇒ **Phase 1 (90-120 Days)**

An intense time of inner searching through a series of book studies, which includes steps 1-5 of the 12-step program and a variety of recovery meetings. Phase 1 goals will be set according to the participants needs.

⇒ **Phase 2 (1-6 Months)**

A continuation of inner searching and healing as working through steps 6-12 and begin the process of seeking employment.

⇒ **Phase 3 (30 to 90 Days)**

This phase implicates that you have worked a good program and should be ready to transition into your new life. The exit/relapse prevention plan will be the requirement worksheet of phase 3. You should now be ready to begin the search for a safe and affordable residence.
